RULES AND REGULATIONS

- Competition is limited to residents of North Carolina.
- Solo and Group competition will be limited to the first ten (10) entries.
- Choir competition will be limited to the first Five (5) entries.
- Contestants must check in 30 minutes prior to the starting time.
- Each performance will be allowed ten (10) minutes. **Each performance is limited to 2 songs.** Contestants going over the ten (10) minute time limit WILL BE DISQUALIFIED. We will not give you any type of time indication. It is suggested that you time yourself to be sure that you stay within the time limitations.
- **Set up time begins when your name is called-Soloist have three (3) minutes to set up. Groups/Choirs have up to eight (8) minutes for setup. Use your time wisely.** Contestants exceeding the set up time limit will be disqualified.
- It is suggested that your instruments be setup prior to the start of the competition. The stage will be open and available prior to start of the competition.
- No entries accepted after August 30 unless entries are needed to fill each category.
- Awards will be announced following the contest. The decision of the judges is final.
- A basic sound system will be provided for amplification of voices, and playback of CD and cassette tracks. We will provide 110 volt power at the stage. We do NOT provide musical instruments, instrument amplifiers and/or speakers or specialized playback equipment like minidisk or MP3 files. Individuals and groups will be completely responsible for providing and setting up extra equipment, and coordinating incorporation of equipment into the provided sound system including all patch cords, electrical extension cords, etc. If in doubt, bring back-up equipment.
- Age should be as of the day of the competition
- **First place in each class will have the opportunity to perform on Thursday, September 16, 2010 before the Christian Concert.**

- 8 minutes - All Traditional Categories (except 4 or More)
- 5 minutes - 4 or More Cpl Open Precision, 4 or More Cpl Open Hoedown, Show (3 minutes setup time)
- 3 minutes - Line, Line Forms, Trad. Line, Exhibition, Small Teams Exhibition, Props Exhibition, Duo/Duets (1 minute setup time)

Min Time Limits: One Half of Max for ALL Contemporary Categories

- Timing for Teams:
- Freestyle FOOTWORK Categories - Begins when last dancer starts dancing and ends when the first dancer stops dancing.
 - Precision FOOTWORK Categories - Begins when the first dancer starts dancing and when the last dancer stops dancing.

Age Divisions:

- Team and Duo/Duet: Tiny Tot 6 and under, Pee Wee 7-9, Elementary 10-12, Junior 13-15, Senior 16-18, Young Adult 19-29, Adult 30-50, Senior Adult 51 & over.
- Solo: 3 and under, 4-5, 6-7, 8-9, 10-11, 12-13, 14-15, 16-19, 20-25, 26-31, 32-40, 41-50, 51 and over
- Flatfoot (Males & Females compete against each other.): 15 and under, 16-30, 31 and over
- Team & Duo/Duet age division is determined by AVERAGE age.

General Information

1. At the Annual Championships in Maggie Valley, a dancer may only dance twice per contemporary dance category – a dancer may only dance ONCE per age division. At regional competitions, there is no limit to the number of times a dancer may dance.
2. Callers of figures must dance on stage with the team.
3. 5 ACHF Certified judges are required. Highest and lowest scores will be dropped and the 3 middle scores averaged.
4. The same 5 judges must judge a dance category. You may not use different judges for different age divisions for the same dance category.
5. An ACHF Certified Rules Official will be in attendance and will have the final say regarding any rules infractions.
6. Point Deductions:
 - A. A 5 point deduction will result if improper number of dancers is used.
 - B. A 1 point deduction for every 15 seconds or portion thereof, exceeding or not meeting the given time limits.
 - C. A 1 point deduction for each dancer not dressed correctly (male position dancer must wear slacks. Female position dancer must wear skirt or dress.
 - D. A 1 point deduction for placing dancers on stage. EXCEPTION: Tiny Tot age division.

- E. A 1 point deduction for a director being at the MC table, Scorers Table, or touching the sound equipment.
 - F. A 1 point deduction for not holding HOME position in Southern Appalachian, Smooth, 4 Couple Precision and 6 or 8 Couple Precision.
 - G. A 1 point deduction for couples not becoming active to perform small circle figures.
 - H. A 1 point deduction for each required figure not performed and each corner / partner swing not performed.
 - I. A 1 point deduction for improper progression.
7. All Solos - 3 judges giving a violation of the dress code and/or Body moves not family orientated.
 8. **DRESS CODE: NO Fannies, NO Midriffs, NO Cleavage, NO ragged clothing in ALL categories!**

 10. Entry form must be sent to the North Carolina Mountain State Fair.

Awards & Premiums

The 1st place team in each division will receive a \$50, 2nd and 3rd place trophies will be given in all divisions. Duos/Duets and Individuals (except Flat Foot) will receive trophies in 1st, 2nd and 3rd places. Overall Team Grand Champion will receive \$200 dollars, Duos/Duets overall will receive \$100 each, Male and Female Solos for Traditional & Contemporary will receive \$100 for Grand Champion. Flatfoot will receive \$50.00 for Grand Champion.

Gate Admission

Teams that are entered with proper entry forms and paid will receive an admission ticket for Friday and/or Saturday. Ticket packets will be at a table outside of gate Entrance E in front of McGough Arena starting Friday at 5:00pm - 9:00pm and Saturday 8:00 am - 1:00 pm. Team Directors can pick up their teams tickets at table. If Team director is not picking up packets please specify on form who is responsible to pick-up packets. All dancers and spectators will enter through Entrance E, main gate. There will be no back gate admission. There will be no tickets required for children 5 years of age and under.

NO TEAM OR DUO/DUET ENTRY WILL BE ACCEPTED AFTER AUGUST 30TH, THIS MEANS NO TEAM OR DUO/DUET ENTRIES WILL BE TAKEN AT THE DOOR. Only Solo entries will be accepted at the door.

Rules and Regulations

- The General Rules and Regulations of the fair will govern this department, except in case of conflict, where the following Rules and Regulations will prevail. Be sure to read the rules in front of this book before entering or competing in this department. Some – but not all – are repeated here for emphasis, along with other rules.
- Open to all residents of the United States of America.
- Bluegrass and Old Time band competitions. Bluegrass and Old Time will each have individual instrument competitions within the band performance.
- To be eligible for prizes, performers must have proper entry forms submitted by the closing date of July 30st.
- Properly entered contestants will have priority on the limited program time.
- Amplified instruments are not used except with prior approval of the director.
- Check with director before show time about setup time for instruments and equipment.
- Contestants should register for the competitions for one day only, however, if your schedule is flexible please indicate 1st, 2nd, and 3rd choices. This will allow the director to schedule in the most efficient and effective manner allowable considering the preferences presented by contestants.
- Judging takes place at all programs and the decision of the judges is final.
- Winners will receive premium money by mail from the NC Mountain State Fair within 60 days.
- The NC Mountain State Fair will furnish the sound system, CD player, and MP3 connection.
- First place band competition winners must perform on Sunday, September 19, 2010 to receive prize money.
- No individual shall be a member of more than one competing band.
- Each band must have at least 3 instruments and 3 members.
- Parking passes and performers passes will be sent by mail to the contact person.
- Please have one member of your group report to the director 30 minutes before show time.
- Each dance team must provide their own dance music. Dance teams perform as exhibition only.
